ELECTRICITY TARIFFS FOR THE PERIOD 01 JULY 2019 – 30 JUNE 2020

Your application dated 30 May 2019 refers.

The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on the 23 May 2019 approved the guideline increase of 13.07% for municipalities applicable for the 2019/20 financial year. Consequently, the Energy Regulator considered your application for a tariff increase for the period 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020 and approved the tariffs as follows:


